NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Declination of Entries: The Hutchinson Kennel Club and the Wichita Dog Training Club, Inc. may decline entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of aggression, disease, deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No one shall have any claim or recourse against the Hutchinson Kennel Club, the Wichita Dog Training Club, Inc., or any official thereof.

Bitches in Season are not permitted in the Trial. The club will refund all but six dollars per day of the entry fees for bitches unable to compete for that reason. **The Trial Secretary must be notified of such claim for refund before the start of the trial at the site or by letter postmarked no later than October 27, 2011.**

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event the dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee or other acts beyond the control of the Trial Committee it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 service charge for any returned checks. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

No Refund for Duplicate Entries. We will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Owners are responsible for errors on entry forms, whoever may have made such errors. No entry will be refunded in the event of such errors, nor will cancellation of entries be allowed after the published closing date.

ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT FEES.

Canadian exhibitors must submit entries with international money orders guaranteed in U.S. funds. Entries not on official AKC Entry Forms and photocopies of the entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms MUST be received in writing or by e-mail prior to the close of entries. Those received by telephone are NOT acceptable.

NO ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED WHICH REQUIRES A SIGNATURE FOR DELIVERY.

Exhibitors must be governed by any rules or regulations or civil authorities, building and parking restrictions. Vehicles parked contrary to regulations will be subject to towing at owner's expense.

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors are acknowledging that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform the obstacles safely.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs Fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club, including ILP/PAL registration (Indefinite Listing Privileges/Purebred Alternative Listing), AKC Canine Partners listing number, and Approved FSS breeds, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.

WAIT LIST

A wait list will be created to fill openings created by entries withdrawn prior to October 15, 2011 at 7:00 PM CDT. A maximum of 25 entries will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to October 13, 2011 at 7:00 PM.. Any entries withdrawn, with notification to the Trial Secretary in writing (e-mail OK) by October 15, 2011 at 7:00 PM CDT will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If, and ONLY if, a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, will a full refund be issued for the withdrawn runs. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by 6 p.m. Monday, October 17, 2011 will receive a full refund for entries not included in the trial.

COURSE SIZE AND SURFACE

A qualifying score is required for all awards. Placement ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 4th place in each height division of each class at each trial. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. New title ribbons will be awarded where appropriate. Clean run ribbons will be available for open and novice runs only. A commemorative MACH/PAX/PACH ribbon and MACH/PAX/PACH bar will be awarded to each dog earning a MACH/PAX/PACH title at these trials.

SPECIAL QUADRUPLE "Q" PRIZE

Every dog/handler team earning a Qualifying Score in each of Standard, JWW, FAST AND Time2Beat in a single trial on Thursday, Friday, or Saturday will receive a gift certificate not to exceed \$25.00. Prize must be claimed on the day of the trial.

MOVE-UPS

Dogs may be moved to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made to the Trial Secretary not later than 6:00 PM C.D.T., Monday, October 24, 2011. Move-ups after Thursday of the trial must be made within 15 min. of the end of the last class. Dogs so moved up will be entered at the end of the running order. Move-ups after Thursday of the trial must be made within 15 min. of the end of the last class. Dogs so moved up will be entered at the end of the running order.

Entry move-up valid only if the dog was already entered at the event and only if approved by the Trial Secretary.

Simplified Jump Height Card Process

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the **Dogs To Be Measured List**. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check in.

How do I know if I have a valid jump height card?

If your dog is under the age of two years as of the trial's date:

- One (1) temporary measurement is required.
- Once measured, be sure to retain the Agility Measurement Form yellow copy and check "My dog has a **Temporary** Jump Height Form" box, otherwise your dog needs to be measured.
- If your dog turns two years of age or is older as of the trial's date, your temporary measurement expires on their 2nd birthday and your dog needs to be measured.

If your dog is the age of two years or older as of the trial's date:

- A minimum of two (2) permanent measurements are required.
- If both permanent measurements place your dog into the same jump height class, the AKC office will issue you a permanent card.
- If not, then a third measurement is required to determine the dog's jump height class.
- Until such time that you have received all required measurements for a permanent jump height card, check the "My dog needs to be measured" box.
- Upon arrival at the trial, you must check to see if there is a Volunteer Measuring Official and/or an Agility Field Rep. present to perform official measurements. If not, and you possess a yellow copy of the Agility Measurement Form from a previous measurement, then your armband may be picked up during Check-In in lieu of being measured by the judge of record.
- Once you have received your permanent card from the AKC office, check the "My dog has a **Permanent** Jump Height Card" box on all future entry forms.

Exception to the 2 permanent measurement requirement:

- If your dog measures over 22 inches at the withers, you have the option of selecting the "Over 22" Reqst Perm" box at the bottom of the Agility Measurement Form to receive a permanent jump height card from AKC after a single measurement.
- If you do so, please also sign below the checkbox. By doing so, you are giving up your right to have a 2nd measurement performed on your dog in the future; however, you are not giving up your right to have the challenge measurement process performed in the future.
- Once you have received your permanent card from the AKC office, check the "My dog has a **Permanent** Jump Height Card" box on all future entry forms.

It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to have their original, official jump height card or temporary jump height form at each trial to present upon request. Additionally, if a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running. Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 2, Section 4.

Height Divisions

Owners are responsible for entering their dogs in the proper height division. For regular agility, exhibitors may choose to enter their dogs in a higher jump height than required, but not in a lower jump height than the AKC mandated height. All dogs entered in Preferred MUST enter the AKC mandated jump height for their measured height.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. **I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners SM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767.
